Thank you for your correspondence dated Nov 5, 2018 regarding Le Chemin de la Montagne. During the summer of 2018 we have received 4 official complaints from two residents dealing with loud ATV's on the roadway disturbing them as well as bonfires near the area where locals have been swimming for decades.

We have conducted immediate patrols in each situation and on one occasion located several ATV's parked on the side of the road. They were spoken to regarding being respectful and mindful of residents in the area.

Also, two of the residents have come to the Meteghan office to speak with me concerning the problem. The problem is identified as bon fires which may cause a forest fire and loud ATV's. As a result I implemented a plan whereby members would conduct patrols in the area in view of identifying infractions and providing visibility.

Despite our efforts we still received complaints from the same two individuals. I had a meeting with both individuals explaining that the police can only conduct so much enforcement and patrols and that they themselves have to be involved in the problem solving process. I further requested their suggestions on how the community and police can work together to try and resolve the issue. I never heard more from them.
